



4-Day Kruger Classic

Add-on before or after your hunting safari

Day 1: Red Ivory Lodge – Kruger Park.

Depart from Red Ivory Lodge between 07:00 – 08:00 and travel to the Kruger National Park. We stop for lunch en-route (drinks at own expense) and reach the Kruger National Park in the afternoon. We check into the park and make our way to the rest camp where we will spend the night.

After settling into our accommodations, you go out on your first game drive which is a sunset drive conducted by South African National Parks. A sunset drive affords you the opportunity to see nocturnal animals. Note that these drives take place in one of the Kruger Parks vehicles with a Parks ranger. This is not a private game drive and there may be other guests on the drive. (Children under 6 years of age are not permitted on open vehicle drives.)

Dinner is enjoyed at the local restaurant, with a spectacular view overlooking rivers and water area as animals come drink water.



Day 2: Activities in the Kruger National Park.

Safaris are all getting out there and seeing animals and since the animals move around we don't stay in the same camp every night. After an early wake-up call we set off on the morning safari in our own private minibus. We make our way towards our next camp and

view the animals as we go. Around lunch time we pull into the closest camp and you can enjoy lunch at the restaurant. After lunch we continue and arrive at the rest camp in the early afternoon.

You then have time to take a siesta or simply relax at the viewing platform so be sure to bring along binoculars and good quality camera equipment.

Dinner is then enjoyed at the local restaurant overlooking animal behaviour.




Day 3: another Day in Kruger.

We leave the camp as soon as the gates open, and see if we can spot the early morning activities of the big 5, making our way towards our last camp we will have breakfast and lunch en-route. After arriving at the camp you can relax and enjoy the facilities at the camp. When night falls you will have another opportunity to see nocturnal animals of Africa as you embark on a night game drive with a Park ranger. Please note again that this is not a private game drive and there may be other guests on this drive. (Children under 6 years of age are not permitted on open vehicle drives.)

Whilst in Kruger Park:

- **Accommodation:** SANPARKS rest camp accommodation located inside the park.
- **Meals & drinks included:** breakfast, lunch and dinner, drinks at/from bar not included.



Day 4: Last day on Safari

The sun rises over your final day in the Park and you have one last chance to find the animals that have eluded you on your journey thus far.

After breakfast we make our way game driving through the park to the exit gate and finally return to Johannesburg. The drive back takes at least 6 hours and it is therefore advisable to sleep over in Johannesburg on this night or you can connect with your departure flight back home.

- **Meals & drinks included:** breakfast and lunch, alcoholic; spirits; drinks not included.
- **All accommodation, transport** during contracted period included.
- Additional accommodation can be arranged at extra cost.
- Add €350 per person per day extra.
- You will be dropped off at the airport (or Hotel) as per arrangement.

End of Tour



Kindly note that you can add more day and more activities to this tour. Hereunder a some activities you may want to add or change for.



Hot air Balloon Flights from Hazyview, Balloon flights take place in the very early mornings before the earth heats up. The launch site is in the beautiful Sabie River Valley.

Mountain- Bike Trails

Swapping four wheels for two may be a wise choice. The most prestigious trails can be found at Olifants Camp where you will be supplied with all the equipment you need. Different trails are available depending on your skill and fitness level.

Guided Bush Walk

Nothing will put you in the heart of an African adventure quite like walking in The Kruger National Park. You will walk with experienced guides. The aim of the walk is to learn and appreciate the intricate details of the nature surrounding you. Once your senses have been activated, you will be able to tune into all the sights, sounds and smells that one often does not get to experience in a vehicle.

Bird Watching

This has become a very popular activity in the Kruger National Park, mostly due to the hugely diverse selection of birds. Birds are in abundance throughout the park but the Northern area of the park is particularly favoured. Some of the birds that are found here can be seen nowhere else in Southern Africa. The Kruger National Park currently has eleven bird hides to choose from and over 226 different species of birds have been sited.

Play Golf

The Kruger National Park sports four courses for you to try your hand at. The Sabie River golf course, the Leopard Creek golf course, Skukuza and the Hans Merensky golf course. As the Park enjoys a sub-tropical climate, golf is best played in the cooler months of winter. This is a great opportunity to get up and close with wildlife, while enjoying 18 holes.
